Career Workshop: "Life After Graduate School - Preparing for Your Job Search" April 9, 2022

We conducted a virtual workshop via zoom for Graduate students and Post Docs in USA to prepare them in their job search after graduate school, followed by a Panel Discussion on different job opportunities in Academia, Industry and National Labs, as well as on Immigration/Working Visa requirements.

More than30 participants attended the session. The workshop was conducted by Dr. Ravi Ranatunga, Director, Corporate Analytical at The Procter & Gamble Company. He is also the Vice President of UPAA-USA. He was supported by below panelists who shared their experiences in their respective careers and provided valuable advice to the participants on things to consider as they go through the job search and application process.

Fundraising

We are working very closely with the Alumni Association of University of Peradeniya (AAUP) in Sri Lanka to allocate the funds to UoP infrastructure and student needs. In the next few weeks, we will provide you a detailed update on how we have allocated the funds for maximum benefit.

We are planning to award need-based scholarships to student from each faculty and currently coordinating with AAUP to organize these scholarships and identify the recipients. In addition, we are looking into installing wi-fi routers in each residential hall throughout the campus which will be beneficial to many students. We will ensure the name of the sponsor is recognized by the residential hall in this project.
